Worship Service

The Christian Race *Apostle Amanda W Bryant*

The Christian Race! Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds (Hebrews 12:1-3). We have to look to Jesus who is the author and finisher of our faith. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1). No matter what those in the Hall of Faith were going through they finished the race. These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth (Hebrews 11:13). That's why we have a great cloud of witnesses cheering us on (Hebrews 12:1). God told Adam not to eat from one tree. And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die (Genesis 2:16-17). When we get out of the will of God we have to face the consequences of our actions. When sin comes in it tries to hide from the light. The light comes in and exposes the darkness. Adam and Eve could not hide from God. And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden (Genesis 3:8). And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. And the Lord God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat (Genesis 3:12-13). Adam wanted to shift the blame on Eve for eating the fruit and disobeying God, and Eve wanted to blame the serpent, neither one of them wanted to take responsibility for what they did. The serpent didn't blame anyone. We will not make it to the finish line running this race in the natural. In this race you need the word of God and the Holy Spirit. You have to know your new identity. Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new (2 Corinthians 5:17). When you get born again it's a spiritual transformation. Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God (John 3:3). Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son (Colossians 1:13). Jesus was the perfect sacrifice. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him (2 Corinthians 5:21).
