

Understanding The Grace Of God! For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God (Ephesians 2:8). Grace is unmerited undeserved unearned favor that we did not have to work for or earn. When we get saved we receive the total package healing, prosperity, deliverance, peace everything we need. Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son (Colossians 1:13). Grace loved us in spite of all our mess ups. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). We have to stop sweeping things under the rug and deal with them. God saved us because of the agape love he had for us. God died once and for all for sin. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16). Jesus operated in grace while he lived on the earth. And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst, They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou? This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground, as though he heard them not. So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her (John 8:3-7). And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing. But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth. And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made the whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague (Mark 5:25-34). We have to stop trying to fix things on our own, and get to know grace..
